
Rosie the Riveter WWII / Home Front National Historical Park

DIRECTIONS TO VISITOR CENTER IN RICHMOND

From San Francisco/Oakland: I-80 East, then take the I-580 West split after the Gilman St. off ramp. EXIT Harbour Way South, then turn Right onto Cutting Blvd, now make a Right at the next stop light onto Harbour Way South and Continue for 0.8 miles.

The San Francisco Bay Trail Project is administered by the Association of Bay Area Governments. The biking and walking trails surround the Bay connecting the shoreline of all nine Bay Area counties, linking 47 cities, and crossing the major toll bridges in the region. To date, approximately 335 miles of the alignment—over 60 percent of the Bay Trail’s ultimate length—have been completed.
