Join the East Bay Regional Park District and special guests as we celebrate the re-opening of this important addition to the San Francisco Bay Trail, renamed in honor of Congressman George Miller. The trail was a part of the historic Carquinez Scenic Drive which closed to vehicles due to landslides in 1983. Significant work to stabilize the segment commenced in 2013. The newly opened trail will provide a safe and accessible route between Martinez, Port Costa, and Crockett for pedestrian, bicycle and equestrian users, and can be used for emergency access.

As a tribute to Congressman George Miller's years of steadfast leadership in Contra Costa County, as well as his exceptional contributions to the East Bay Regional Park District, the entire Bay Area and the nation, which have resulted in major positive impacts with enduring importance, EBRPD's Board of Directors this year approved the naming of this beautiful and scenic segment of the San Francisco Bay Trail as the George Miller Regional Trail. EBRPD's dedication celebration will include guest speakers with a ceremonial ribbon-cutting, followed by light refreshments.



## Driving Directions

### From northbound I-680 in Martinez:

Exit at Marina Vista (the last northbound exit) and turn left. Proceed through Martinez to Talbart Street. Turn right onto Talbart. After two blocks, bear left; you are now on Carquinez Scenic Drive. Drive for about 0.29 miles to reach the Nejedly Staging Area, and an additional 1.6 miles to reach the parking area, turning right.

### From Hwy 4 in Martinez:

Exit Alhambra Avenue. Turn right on Alhambra. Proceed through Martinez to Buckley Street, turning left to continue on to Buckley. Turn right onto Talbart Street. After two blocks, bear left; you are now on Carquinez Scenic Drive. Drive for about 0.29 miles to reach the Nejedly Staging Area, and an additional 1.6 miles to reach the parking area, turning right.

Event parking signs will be posted. The event location will be held at the George Miller Trailhead Gate near the parking area. Overflow parking will be allowed along Carquinez Scenic Drive. Shuttles will be available, if assistance is needed from parking.

Please note: the George Miller Trail will be closed prior and during the ceremony. It will be opened following the ceremonial ribbon-cutting.
