

Directions to Ferry Point Pier Dedication



From the East Bay

From I-580 in Richmond, exit at the Canal Blvd. exit and turn left onto Canal Blvd. Turn right onto W. Cutting Blvd., then left onto Doran Dr. Proceed through the tunnel, drive for about one-half mile, and turn right into the Miller-Knox Regional Shoreline parking lot. Watch for the event parking directions.

From San Rafael

From I-580 in San Rafael, cross the bay on the Richmond-San Rafael Bridge. Exit at Canal Blvd. and turn right onto Canal Blvd. Turn right onto W. Cutting Blvd., then left onto Doran Dr. Proceed through the tunnel, drive for about one-half mile, and turn right into the Miller-Knox Regional Shoreline parking lot. Watch for the event parking directions.
